Dear Lambert's Point City Park Steering Committee:

I am writing to extend our support to the steering committee and the establishment of a public city park at the former Lambert's Point Golf Course.

City parks and green space unite communities by providing a sense of place, improve general well-being through recreation, and beautify our urban environment. These outcomes mirror those realized through the non-automobile-centric transportation systems promoted by Norfolk Bike Commuter (NFKBC).
